

Coast Hills Student Life Code of Conduct

Our desire is to give each student an amazing camp experience, where they will connect in community and encounter God without distractions of harm emotionally, physically or spiritually. To help aid this, our camp staff is trained and prepared to offer the best support, protection and learning experiences for students. To help us do this we have put in place the following *Code of Conduct* that each, student, staff and family will be held to. Your prayers for all our students and staff are coveted as we experience camp together!

Code of Conduct

We believe deeply in creating environments where students are safe and connect through love and grace. Our code of conduct is simple and direct.

1. Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco and Weapons are prohibited

Students caught with or involved with any of the above will be immediately disciplined through the following: Substances, paraphernalia, weapons will be confiscated permanently, parents will be contacted immediately and the student will be sent home at the families expense immediately. (*Note: All medications, whether prescribed or over the counter, must be in original manufacturer's packaging and/or pharmaceutical approved packaging with pharmacy labels containing medicine name, student name, doctors name and dosage required. Medications not in appropriate packaging will be considered and handled as contraband)

2. **Bullying, Teasing, Gossiping is unacceptable** (this includes pranking, coarse talk, coarse joking, and any suggestive talk on race, sex or prejudice) Students involved in this kind of activity will be immediately disciplined through the following: 1st time: Reprimand – 2nd time: Reprimand and loss of activity privileges without refund – 3rd time: Student will be sent home at families expense.

3. Fighting is unacceptable

Students involved in fighting will be immediately disciplined through the following: 1st time: Reprimand – 2nd time: Reprimand and loss of activity privileges without refund – 3rd time: Student will be sent home at families expense. If there is any physical damage caused to or by any student, all families will be contracted immediately and informed of the incident.



4. Vandalism is unacceptable

Students involved in any kind of vandalism and damage to personal property, private property or public property will be immediately disciplined through the following: 1st time: Reprimand – 2nd time: Reprimand and loss of activity privileges without refund – 3rd time: Student will be sent home at families expense. The family will pay for any and all damages directly to the vandalized party.

5. Inappropriate physical contact is unacceptable

Students are expected to be respectful and honoring of themselves and others by not participating in any intimate physical contact beyond hand holding and brief hugging. Students involved will be disciplined through the following: 1st time: Reprimand – 2nd time: Reprimand and loss of activity privileges without refund – 3rd time: Student will be sent home at the families expense.

I accept this *Code of Conduct* and agree to abide by them and in the case of any code being broken I agree to accept the full responsibility and disciplinary consequences.
